Creating **sustainable careers** for Gippslanders.



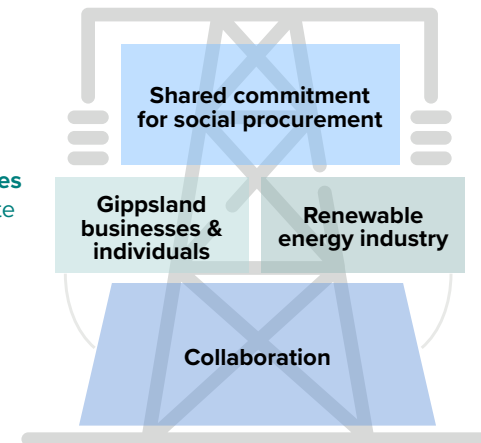
What is the GiPPI

- D** Structured collaboration to activate social procurement in renewable energy

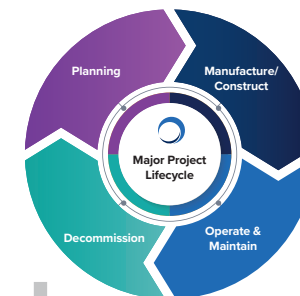
