

Micro-Credentials

Recognising skills wherever they are



Want to improve your chances of getting a job or a promotion you've been after?

Micro-credentials allow you to be recognised for the skills that employers are looking for, by presenting evidence of your skills. This evidence is then assessed, and you can earn a micro-credential.

The Gippsland Enterprise Micro-credentials have been developed by a range of key local employers and education providers from energy, health, recruitment, water, community services, government, food and fibre and manufacturing.

What skills can I get recognised?

Local employers have told us what's important to them when recruiting. At this stage we are running an initial program for communication, collaboration and problem solving. You can apply for one or all skills.

What will I need to do?

- An online quiz where you will be presented with real life scenarios and how you would respond to them.
- A survey about yourself.
- You will also need to nominate four people to complete a survey about you.

What will I receive?

If you're successful in completing the program, you will receive a Gippsland Enterprise Skill Profile for the skill/s you have selected. The Profile will show you the level you have achieved in each skill. This profile will be warranted by the University of Melbourne and include their logo - a great addition to your resume.



How to get started

Decide which skill/s you would like to get recognised. You can select one, two or all three:

- Communication
- Problem Solving
- Collaboration

Think of people that know you well, and would be able to answer some questions about the skill/s you've chosen.

You must nominate 4 people to complete a survey, you'll need their name, email address and phone number.

When can I do this?

Phase 3 will run from **June to July**. Successful candidates will receive a Gippsland Enterprise Skill Profile in August.
